

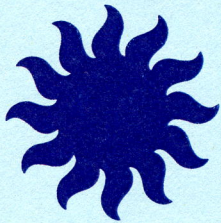


LAFAYETTE RESERVOIR RECREATION AREA

HIKING, WALKING, JOGGING

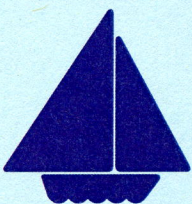


Lakeside Trail 2.7 miles - paved
(marked at 1/4 mile intervals)
Rim Trail 4.7 miles - dirt

Bicycles/Rollerskates/Blades/Scooters
Tues & Thurs: noon until closing
Sunday: from opening until 11 am
(on paved trail only), no skateboards.

Self-guided nature trail: 928 acres of open space. Pets must be on a leash at all times; leash must not extend more than 6 ft. Pets are not allowed in boats or water. Pet owners are required to pick up after their animals and are also required to have the means to do so in their possession at all times.

PRIVATE BOATS



Car top boats only. (7' 10" min. length). No trailers or gas engines allowed. Electric motors OK. Float tubes restricted to the East Cove.
Daily Launch Fee \$4.00
Annual \$45.00
Senior \$22.50

126 acres of lake surface

All boats must be off lake 2½ hours prior to closing.

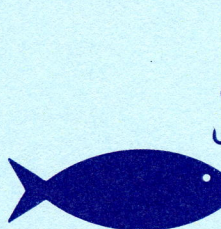
BOAT RENTALS



• 1 hour	\$15.00
• 1-1.5 hrs	\$22.50
• 1.5 - 5 hrs	\$25.00
• 5+ hrs	\$35.00

\$40.00 deposit required on all rentals. Must be at least 18 yrs old to rent. 1/2 off on boat rentals for seniors (62 yrs) and permanently disabled on weekdays only (non-holidays.) Boats are available on a first-come, first-served basis. **Rentals stop 3½ hours prior to park closing.** Boats must be off the water 2½ hours prior to park closure.

FISHING



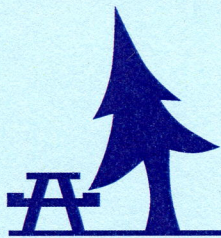
Daily Fishing Access Permit and State License required. No live bait allowed, except for worms.

Daily Limits:

Rainbow Trout	5
Black Bass	5 (12" min.)
Catfish	10
Bluegill	No limit
Crappie	25
